The American Indian Relations Administrator will focus on work across the organization to reduce barriers for the American Indian community and advocate for system change. The American Indian Relations Administrator will collaborate with Racial and Health Equity Administrators, with an emphasis on American Indian community, to advance Ramsey County's strategic planning activities focusing on equity across the county system so that race can no longer be used to predict life outcomes for residents.

This position reports to a member of the Director of Policy and Administrative Strategy. The American Indian Relations Administrator will work on site for at least two days a week and will also need to have transportation to and from community meetings to work closely with American Indian community leaders and Indigenous-led nonprofits that serve the community.

Preferred education and work experience:

- Working across local government and community-based organizations advocating for the American Indian community in Ramsey County.
- Knowledge of the American Indian community and existing relationships with community/neighborhood organizations within Ramsey County.
- Development and implementation of culturally relevant technical assistance for the organization.

This role is scheduled to begin January 1st, 2026.
